- _____ Scissors labeled with name (**Fiskars preferred**)
- _____ Workbox (approximately **8 in. x 5 in.**), labeled with name
- _____ 3 plastic or heavy duty pocket folders with the pockets on the **bottom**, not the sides (one red, one yellow, and **one** of your choice)
- _____ 1 green, 1 orange, and 1 blue plastic 3-prong pocket folder
- _____ 3 yellow highlighters
- _____ 2 4-packs of black Expo or Bic **fine** whiteboard markers
- _____ 1 **wide ruled** one subject notebook
- _____ 1 1-inch binder with a clear cover to slip papers in
- _____ 1 3- hole punched zipper pouch for a binder
- _____ Headphones (removed from packaging at home and labeled with your child's name)
