As you may be aware, New York State Governor Kathy Hochul announced that the statewide mask requirement in schools will be lifted on Wednesday, March 2.

This means that starting Wednesday, March 2, students, school staff and visitors will no longer be required to wear face coverings or masks in any of our school buildings or on school buses.
