The following applications are now available in the Counseling and Career Services Office or online. Please be sure to note deadline dates. This is very important to ensure that applications will be on time to the individual corporations/organizations.

American College Foundation Visionary Scholarship Program- DEADLINE: May 1st

High school freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors who are US citizens or eligible non-citizens are invited to apply. The scholarship program offers multiple awards, with a top prize of \$5000. Each award is non-renewable, one-time award and is to be used exclusively to offset costs and fees related directly to the student's first year of higher post-secondary education. American Fire Sprinkler Association Scholarship- DEADLINE: April 1st

American Legion Scholarships- DEADLINE: April 15th

The American Legion Legacy Scholarship is a needs-based scholarship designed to fulfill a financial gap remaining after all federal and state educational grants/scholarships available to an eligible applicant have been utilized. Who is eligible: Children of U.S. military members who died while on active duty on or after Sept. 11, 2001. Children of post-9/11 veterans having been assigned a combined disability rating of 50 percent or greater by the Department of Veterans Affairs also qualify. Athnet Sports Recruiting Scholarship- DEADLINE: Various

This scholarship is available to undergraduates who were athletes at the high school level. You do not need to be an athlete at the college level. Award amount is \$1000. Students must be enrolled as a full time student at a two or four year college. Captain John H. larrobino Scholarship- DEADLINE: April 17th

To be eligible for this scholarship the applicant must be a resident of the Oriskany Central School District or a descendant of the USS Oriskany crew member. Central New York Kennel Club, Inc. Monetary Award- DEADLINE: March 30th

Open to all high school seniors and juniors. Applicants must be a high school senior or junior and reside in Herkimer, Oneida, or Madison County. They are particularly interested in young people who volunteer at shelters, human societies, or veterinary offices, are active in the 4H program, work at animal related business, and experience in showing, performance, conformation event, and/or training dogs. Donald F. Sheehan Scholarship- DEADLINE: May 1st

This scholarship was established in memory of CW04 Donald F. Sheehan USN (Ret) who was a naval photographer and served aboard the USS Oriskany CV-34. Student must be a resident of Oriskany Central School District. Student must possess some experience in photography, media, and communications through classwork and outside activities. Applications will be available in the counseling office after the new year.

Helen Townsend Scholarship Trust- DEADLINE: May 15th

Open to seniors who are residents of the City of Rome or the towns immediately contiguous to it. Students must be attending universities, colleges or institutions of higher learning, be a person of good character, good scholastic achievement, and one who requests scholarship assistance due to need. Applications will be available in the counseling office.

Horatio Alger National Career & Technical Scholarship Program- DEADLINE: April 15th

In order to be eligible for this scholarship you must complete high school or earned a high school equivalency degree by Spring 2020, be enrolled in a 2-year of less career or technical degree/certificate program in the fall that will lead to employment, attend a not-for-profit secondary institution, demonstrate financial need (applicants must be Pell Grand eligible), be under the age of 30, and be a United States citizen. Kathleen A. Clements Scholarship- DEADLINE: April 10th

Kathryn L. Brown Memorial Scholarship- DEADLINE: May 1st

Oriskany Retirees' Organization Scholarship- DEADLINE: April 17th by 11am

Two scholarships will be awarded to seniors who have successfully completed high school and are scheduled for full-time study at a career or technical, military, and/or a 2 or 4 year college in the next academic year. Rome Community Foundation 20th Anniversary Scholarship- DEADLINE: May 1st

Volunteer Service Awards in the amount of \$500 will be awarded to qualified students residing in the New York Mills, Oriskany, and Whitesboro school districts. All students are eligible.
